



# Amendment Notice to Pages 7, 8, 14, 21, 22, 24, 33, 36, 44, 48, 50, 67

- **Page 7, 44, 48, 50 – FINISHED ENTRIES**

In the printed version, it states “Finished - entries not to exceed 30 dogs per flight.”

The digital version has been corrected to state “Finished - entries not to exceed 40 dogs per flight.”

- **Page 8 - CLOTHING**

A new policy has been added.

The digital version has been corrected to state “Handlers may have the option of removing their hat to use while handling their dog. Once the hat is removed, handling will be judged.”

- **Page 14 – BASE REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL JUDGES**

In the printed version, it states “The individual must attend a judge’s/handler’s seminar once every three (3) years.”

The digital version has been corrected to state “The individual must attend a judge’s/handler’s seminar once every two (2) years.”

- **Page 21, 22, 24 - TO MAINTAIN YOUR JUDGE LICENSE**

In the printed version, it states “Attend an HRC Judge’s/Handler’s Seminar once every three (3) years.”

The digital version has been corrected to state “Attend an HRC Judge’s/Handler’s Seminar once every two (2) years.”

- **Page 24 - SEMINARS**

In the printed version, it states “All judges are required to attend the HRC Judges/Handlers Seminar once every three (3) years. The 3-year term of the seminar requirement will be extended to Dec. 31, three years from the year of any seminar taken.”

The digital version has been corrected to state “All judges are required to attend the HRC Judges/Handlers Seminar once every two (2) years. The 2-year term of the seminar requirement will be extended to Dec. 31, two years from the year of any seminar taken.”

- **Page 33 – FINISHED HUNT TEST PURPOSE AND PHILOSOPHY**

In the printed version, it states “duplicates actual hunting conditions found throughout the local area.”

The digital version has been corrected to state “duplicates actual hunting conditions found throughout the country.”

- **Page 36 – UPLAND HUNT TEST PURPOSE AND PHILOSOPHY**

In the printed version, it states “duplicates actual hunting conditions found throughout the local area.”

The digital version has been corrected to state “duplicates actual hunting conditions found throughout the country.”

- **Page 67 – FINISHED TEST RULES**

In the printed version, it states “The honor dog will be excused from the test after the working dog has left the retrieving line.”

The digital version has been corrected to state “The honor dog will be excused from the test after the working dog has left the retrieving line on its way to retrieve one of the marks thrown in the test.”
