CURRENT RULE WORDING:

The blind retrieve maximum test distance will not exceed 100 yards.

PROPOSED CHANGE:

The blind retrieve maximum test distance will not exceed 125 yards.

JUSTIFICATION:

125 yards max distance can better align with the grand standard of 150 yards max distance for a blind and sometimes when You are given grounds that don't have cover or features to set up a proper finished test. The extra distance can allow for The judges to get a proper finished set up.
