IF A DIVERSIONARY BIRD IS THROWN ON THE INITIAL CAST, THE JUDGES SHOULD SPECIFY WHETHER OR NOT THE RETRIEVES SHOULD BE MADE IN ANY ESTABLISHED SEQUENCE. IF THE DOG IF THE DOG SWITCHES ON A DIVERSIONARY BIRD THROWN ON THE RETURN OF A RETRIEVE, THE TEST WILL BE FAILED. Remember that when a hazard or a diversion of any kind is set out for yhe dog, it is the recovery that the dog executes that is important.
