No refunds are given for scratches for any other reason.)

ALL HANDLERS MUST CHECK-IN STARTING AT 6:30 AM EACH DAY. Handlers/owners not checked in by 7:30 a.m. are subject to removal and running entry given to dogs on wait list, if any.

Owner/handlers may NOT substitute dogs for any reason after the Close date (2/27/24) without approval of the Hunt Secretary. If a handler removes a dog, for any reason, that running entry will be given to the next dog on the wait list, if any. A handler with multiple dogs who removes a dog may place another dog at the end of the wait list, if any.
