Please be aware that the Lee Kay access gate may be locked during the night and during non-event hours. An electronic lock that can be opened with a smart phone is now being used on the gate.

DIRECTIONS

The grounds are located at approximately 6500 West 2100 South, west of the adjacent Lee Kay Public Shooting Center (LKPSC) on the north side of State Road 201 in Salt Lake City (GPS Coordinates N40 43.539 W112 03.088).

To reach the grounds from SR 201, exit 5600 West and head north to 1730 South. Turn West onto 1730 South and follow the road past the LKPSC. After .121 mi. from the LKPSC gate bear right onto the gravel road. Proceed down the gravel road .464 mi. to the front gate to the trial grounds on your right (across from the gravel pit). To reach the porta potties and camping area, continue through the gate, take the first left and then the next left and proceed until you reach the area. As you entered that first gate there should be signs directing you to the specific stakes.
