SCRATCHES

A scratch occurring after the Close Date (9/3/2024) due to illness or injury of dog/handler, or bitch in season, requires a doctor/veterinarian's certificate to receive a refund of entry fee (less a \$15 bird fee if the category does not fill up). To receive a refund handlers must provide a certificate to the Hunt Secretary up to one week after the Hunt Test dates (unless reason for scratch is approved during the hunt test). No refunds are given for scratches for any other reason.

ALL HANDLERS MUST CHECK-IN STARTING AT 6:45AM EACH DAY. Handlers/owners not checked in by 7:30 a.m. are subject to removal and running entry given to dogs on wait list, if any.

Owner/handlers may NOT substitute dogs for any reason after the Close date (9/3/24) without approval of the Hunt Secretary. If a handler removes a dog, for any reason, that running entry will be given to the next dog on the wait list, if any. A handler with multiple dogs who removes a dog may place another dog at the end of the wait list, if any.
