A SCRATCH occurring after the Close Date (3/31/2026) due to illness or injury of dog/handler, or bitch in season, requires a doctor/veterinarian's certificate to receive a refund of entry fee (less a \$15 bird fee if the category does not fill up). To receive a refund handlers must provide a certificate to the Hunt Secretary up to one week after the Hunt Test dates (unless reason for scratch is approved during the hunt test). No refunds are given for scratches for any other reason.
