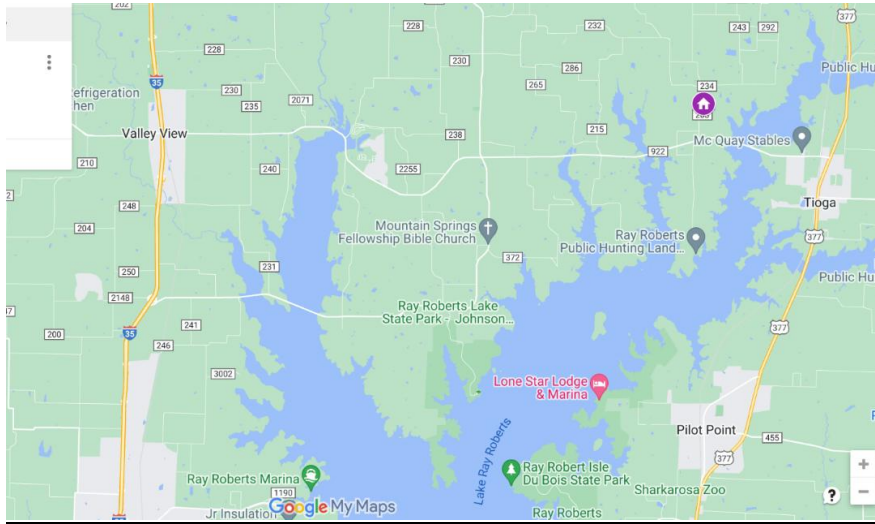

From I-35: Exit to FM 922 at Valley View, travel east 13 miles to County Road 203, turn north travel 7/10 mile to B&L Ranch, turn right into the entrance.

From US 75: Exit #51 to Farm 121 at Van Alstyne, travel west 22 miles to US 377, turn north travel 7/10 mile to FM 922, turn west travel 3 miles to Country Road 203, turn north travel 7/10 mile to B&L Ranch turn right into the entrance.
