SCRATCHES

Scratches require veterinarian's certificate for Illness, Injury or Bitch in Season Dog substitution after online closing will incur a \$10.00 per dog/per day fee unless accompanied with a vet certificate. Scratches on Sunday due to a title on Saturday will not be refunded, but may enter higher stake based upon availability.

COURSES

All Hunts will use: **Ducks. Shot Flyers may be shot in Finished. Chukar or Quail in Upland.** Clothing worn in retrieving hunt tests by judges, hunt marshals, gunners and handlers must be full camouflage per the Clothing Policy stated in the current HRC Rulebook. Bring knee/hip waders for Seasoned & Finished. Bring orange hat & vest for Upland.
